**DRAFT MINUTES OF THE TELECONFERENCE MEETING OF

1. Call To Order

Mr. Landau called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

2. Roll Call and Review of Agenda

Ms. Jones conducted a roll call, a quorum of Committee members were present. The Executive Director reviewed the agenda.

Mr. Landau welcomed all attendees and thanked them for participating.

3. Call to the Public

There were no individuals present for the call to the public.

4. Discussion, consideration and possible action relating to Interstate Compact Licensing Agreement.

After discussion and consideration, the committee voiced concerns about portions of the document. The first item involved the immediate suspension of a license as a result of an action taken by a sister board and how that may affect the Board's authority on a physician's license. The other area included questions regarding the powers and duties of the executive committee of the compact commission.

No action was taken other than for staff to present the concerns to FSMB and table it for further review once FSMB responds. The committee expects to take it to the Board in November.

5. Discussion, consideration and possible action relating to pursuing legislation during this next legislative session.

After discussion and consideration, Mr. Landau made a motion for the committee to recommend the Board move forward with a legislative package this next session. Dr. Ward seconded. Motion passed. The committee will hold another conference at the end of August to discuss legislative language changes and present them along with their recommendation to the Board at its September meeting.
