1. CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Steingard called the meeting to order at 6:22 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL AND REVIEW OF AGENDA

The Executive Director took the roll. Five Board members were present telephonically or at the Board office, establishing quorum for the meeting. The Executive Director reviewed the agenda.

3. CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Mr. Landau wanted to thank the board and staff for their support of his recent election to the FSMB Board of Directors. He was happy to report that he was elected for a three-year term.

4. BOARD MAY REVIEW, DISCUSS, AND TAKE ACTION ON PROPOSED CONSENT AGREEMENT

A. Afeworki Kidane, D.O. Case Nos. DO-12-0081A and DO-12-011A License No. 4458

Ms. Jones reviewed the case. Dr. Kidane was present telephonically. It was determined that the board could not impose a practice restriction as a non-disciplinary action but could issue non-disciplinary CME.

MOTION: Mr. Landau moved to amend the proposed Consent Agreement by stating that it adopted the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issued on January 30, 2014. His motion included the offer for Dr. Kidane to complete 80 non-disciplinary CMEs along with the understanding that once he completed the CMEs, the practice restriction would be lifted. Dr. Erbstoesser seconded.

VOTE: Roll call vote, five ayes (two absent). Motion passed 5-0.
